KHATYN

State Memorial Complex “Khatyn”

Today you won't find this Belarusian village on the geographical map, even the most detailed. It was destroyed by fascists in the spring of 1943.

***Khatyn** was a village in Logojsk district in Minsk region in Belarus. It became a symbol of Belarusian people's tragedy. It's a mournful history page of the Great Patriotic War.*

In honour of 2.230.000 victims (one in four victims in Belarus) a memorial complex was constructed at the place of the burnt village Khatyn in 1969. The idea of people's courage and invincibility is incorporated here, the courage that brought incalculable victims for the sake of achieved victory.

During «The Memorial Complex Khatyn» excursion you'll see streets of former village, you will pass 26 pipes-obelisks, where houses were earlier, you'll hear plaintive sounds of bells, you'll visit the just one in the world memorial cemetery of villages, as well as the memory Wall of concentration camps prisoners. You can honour the memory of the victims with a minute of silence against the Eternal Flame.
